What is **Evernote**?

- Evernote is a notebook container.
- Evernote is a note-taking and a note-filing system.
- Evernote holds multiple notes within multiple notebooks.
- Evernote is a container for every scrap of paper, every note, and every digital scrap of paper that you save, putting them all in one convenient place.

...what is **Evernote**?

- Evernote syncs all of your information across the web, your computer, and all of your mobile devices so that your notes go with you everywhere.
- Evernote makes all of your files searchable, even within an image.
- Evernote can be described as an "everything bucket."

...what is **Evernote**?

• In short: where you have piles of notes, piles of printouts, and piles of paper on your desk, on your computer, in your notebooks, and in your filing cabinets, you can now put all of these things into one searchable software application—Evernote.

Definitions Used in Evernote


Note: A single item stored in **Evernote**.

Notebook: A container for notes.

Sync: The process by which your **Evernote** notes are kept up to date across all of your computers, phones, devices and the Web.

Account : A username and password that allows **Evernote** to identify your notes and make them available to you anywhere.




Creating a Notebook

- Type a name for the Notebook.




Creating a Basic Text Note

Tags are keywords that are attached to Notes to help describe their contents.





- Give the Notebook stack a more descriptive name.








Emailing to Evernote

We all get a lot of email. When you get something worth storing—jokes, documents, medical records, travel reservations, pictures, and the like—Evernote provides a private email address to make that happen with a simple forward of the message. To find your special address, check Account Info in the apps. Give that address out to your friends and they can send things to your **Evernote** account as well. The subject line will become the name of the note. You can make sure it's filed right by adding @notebook, !date for a reminder, and/or #tag. Here's an example: Lowes Hose Purchase @Receipt !2014/05/05 #household.



Capturing Screen/Part of Screen




Right click on **Evernote** icon In System Tray.

Then Click on Clip Screenshot

To clip a window, click window as crosshairs become active. To clip part of desktop, draw a rectangle with crosshairs.

Clipping the Web with Web Clipper

Perhaps the most important part of Evernote is the **Evernote Web Clipper.** The Web Clipper is a browser extension for Chrome, Firefox, Opera, Safari, and becomes part of Internet Explorer when you install **Evernote** for Windows. With Web Clipper, you can capture everything you see online, from an entire page to just one little section or picture. A menu will fly out from the right and provide several of options, from changing the notebook to inserting arrows or highlights or annotations. All it takes is a click on the Evernote icon.
