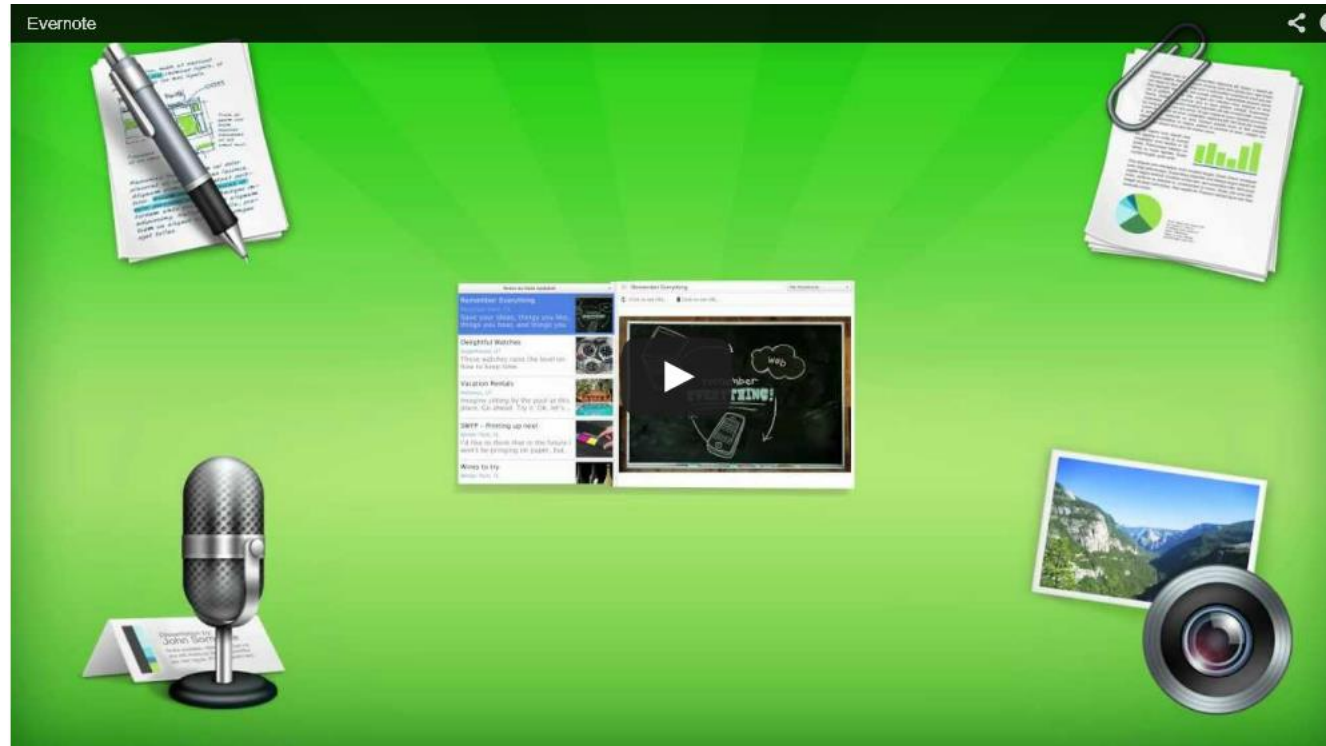

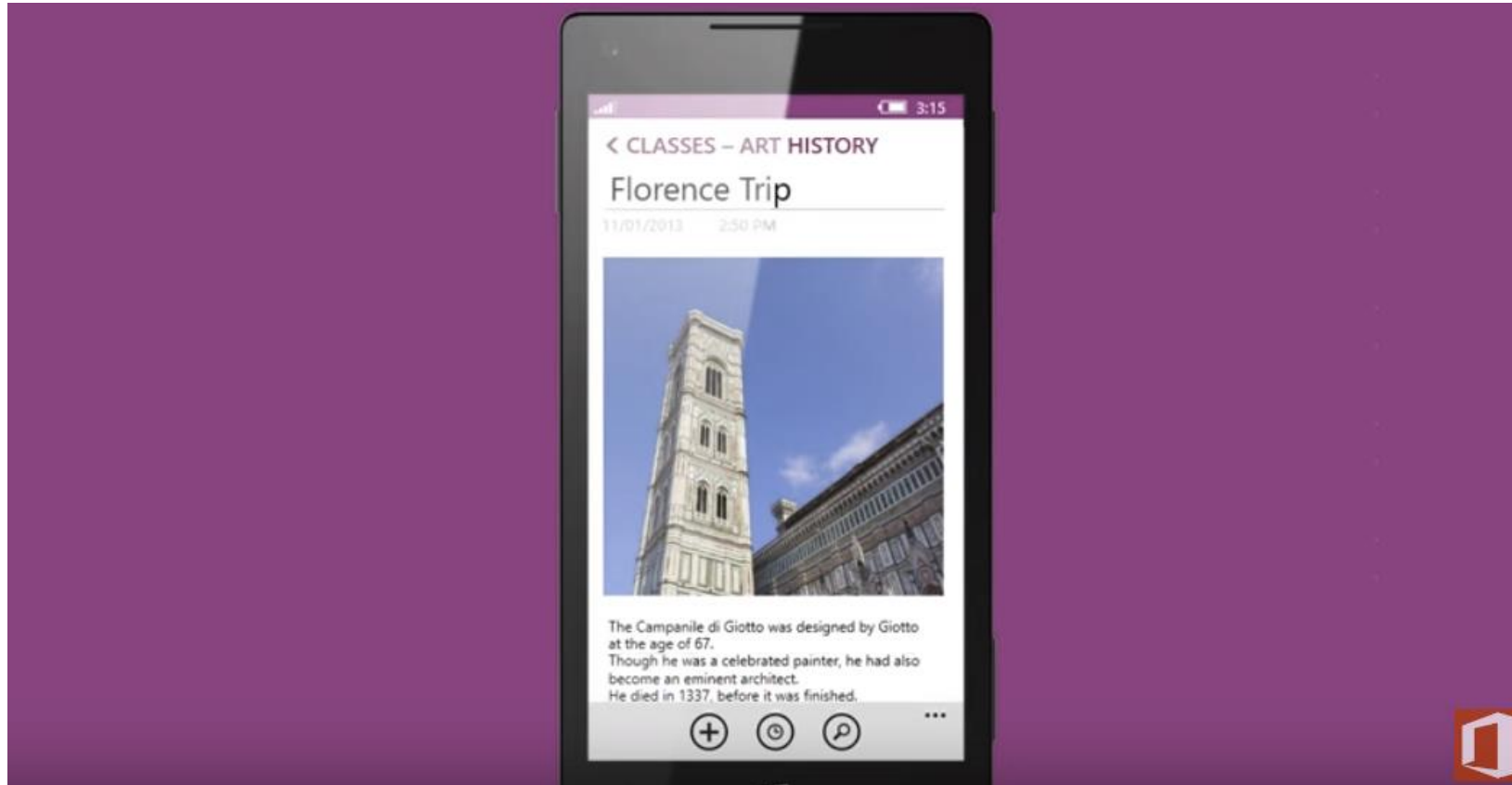

OneNote Introduction

What is **Evernote**?

- **Evernote** is a notebook container.
- **Evernote** is a note-taking and a note-filing system.
- **Evernote** holds multiple notes within multiple notebooks.
- **Evernote** is a container for every scrap of paper, every note, and every digital scrap of paper that you save, putting them all in one convenient place.



. . .what is **Evernote**?

- **Evernote** syncs all of your information across the web, your computer, and all of your mobile devices so that your notes go with you everywhere.
- **Evernote** makes all of your files searchable, even within an image.
- **Evernote** can be described as an “everything bucket.”



. . .what is **Evernote**?

- In short: where you have piles of notes, piles of printouts, and piles of paper on your desk, on your computer, in your notebooks, and in your filing cabinets, you can now put all of these things into one searchable software application—**Evernote**.

What is OneNote?

All your notes—even words in pictures—are searchable inside OneNote, and they're stored in the cloud and immediately accessible via the OneNote apps for any platform.

If you do a lot of notetaking and collaborate with others on projects, then OneNote can keep that flood of info neat and tidy.

Emailing to **Evernote** or **OneNote**


We all get a lot of email. When you get something worth storing—jokes, documents, medical records, travel reservations, pictures, and the like—**Evernote** and **OneNote** provide a private email address to make that happen with a simple forward of the message. To find your special address, check Account Info in the apps. Give that address out to your friends and they can send things to your **Evernote** or **OneNote** accounts as well. The subject line will become the name of the note.




Clipping the Web with Web Clipper


Perhaps the most important part of both **Evernote** and **OneNote** is the **Web Clipper**. The Web Clipper is a browser extension for Chrome, Firefox, Opera, Safari, and Edge. With Web Clipper, you can capture everything you see online, from an entire page to just one little section or picture. A menu will fly out from the right and provide several of options. All it takes is a click on the **Evernote** or **OneDrive** icon.








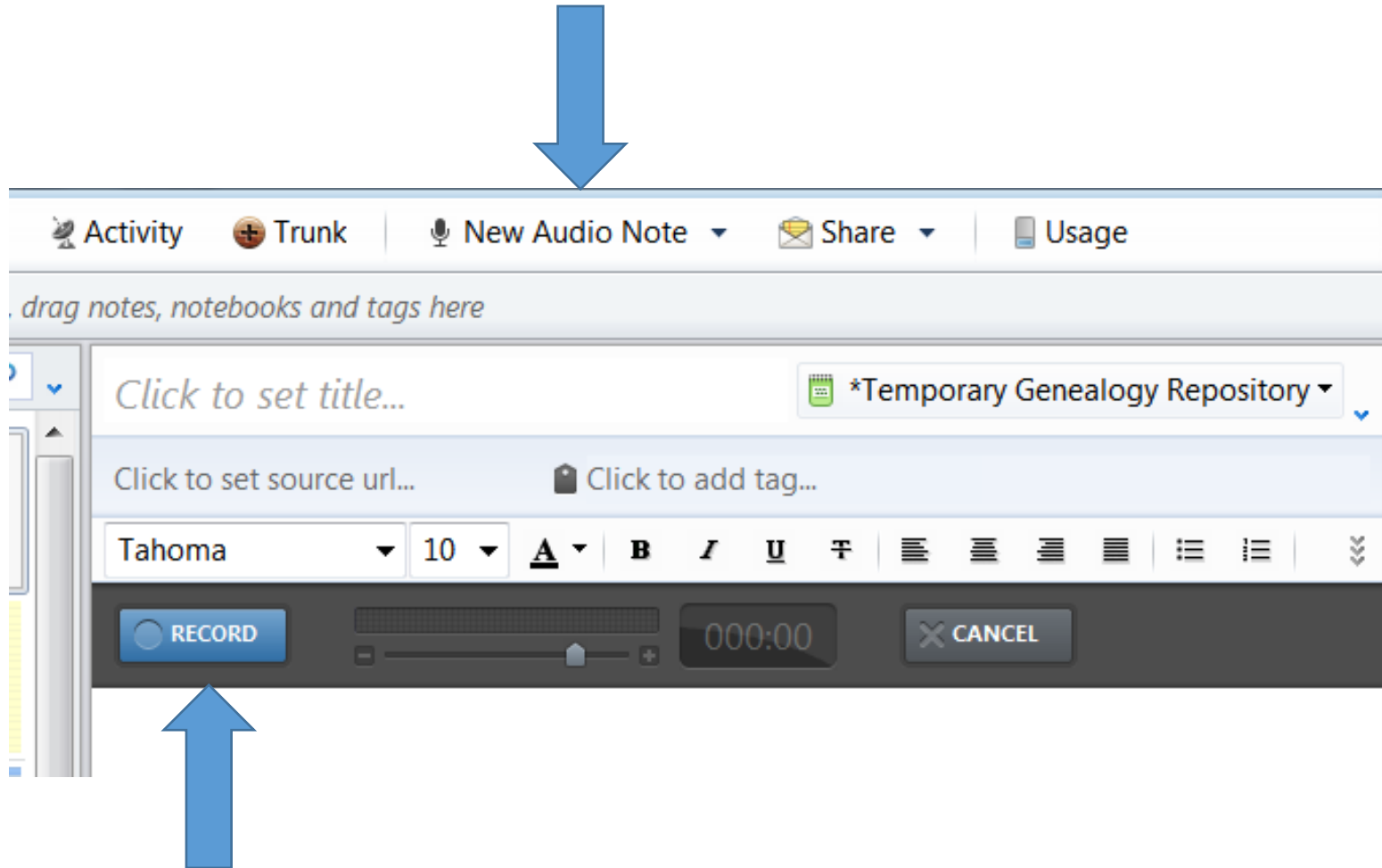




Creating an Ink Note in Evernote and OneNote

Evernote Cons

- Notebook organization inferior to OneNote.
- Max file size 25mb, 50mb, 200mb for free, plus, premium tiers.
- No email forwarding in free version.



OneNote Cons

- Confusing—too many versions.
- Too many differences between versions
- Sluggish.
- Fewer features than Evernote.
- Still adding features to catch up with Evernote.
- Free version doesn't allow off-line access.



Evernote Pros

- **Web clipping far superior to OneNote.**
- **Almost no training required.**
- **Super flexible.**
- **Easier to use on all devices than OneNote.**
- **Extremely responsive throughout.**

- Windows 10 OneNote app is free.
